Under the direction of Port Engineer, this position is responsible for fueling vessels, performing regularly scheduled lubrication duties on vessels and driving a black water tank truck.

### **Duties/Responsibilities**

- ✓ Fuel nine tour vessels with assistance.
- ✓ Perform engine oil changes on a fleet of nine vessels.
- ✓ Do required driveline lubrications on vessels.
- ✓ Drive black water tank truck on highway on a varied schedule.
- ✓ Be able to work unsupervised.
- ✓ Work safely in a fast-paced environment.
- ✓ Be able to communicate effectively with a small team of fellow employees.
- ✓ Assist in monitoring of maintenance inventory (i.e. lube oil, filters, tools, etc.).
- ✓ Communicate problems to Port Engineer.
- ✓ Keep dock and shop areas clean, safe and free from hazards to maintain a safe working environment.
- ✓ Be flexible in prioritizing daily work activities.
- ✓ Maintain personal appearance as per the employee manual.

### **Qualifications/Experience**

- Must possess current CDL class B driver's license **or** be willing to acquire it within reasonable period of time to accomplish duties of position.
- Applicant should be able to pick up at least 50 pounds in line of duties.
- Be comfortable working around diesel engines.
- Possess some experience with mechanic's tools.
- Must be self-motivated and be able to work unsupervised.
- Must be able to work varied shifts, some weekends and some holidays.
- Must be drug free (pre-employment screening and enrollment in random drug testing program is Coast Guard required).
- Must be able to work from mid April to the end of September with little or no interruption.
